Welcome to the first newsletter of the project *Gender Education of Teenage Boys: Developing a Digital ToolKit (G. EDU)*; a transnational Erasmus+ project aiming to create an online learning environment on gender education for teenage boys!

We are creating an online educational toolkit which will provide users with learning material and tools for the facilitation of a complete online course—including curriculum, lesson plans and study material—on gender education with focus on the educational needs of boys in the adolescent ages of 15 to 17 years old.

If you are a trainer, a teacher, a youth worker, a gender expert, or a teenager this course may interest you!

The course will be openly accessible to the public and can be used by educators or facilitators and other professionals such as trainers, teachers, youth workers, NGO workers, gender experts, equality activists, LGBTIQ+ activists, policy makers and other stakeholders. These professionals, who are the main target audience, could either use the lesson plans and material to facilitate a complete course, or could choose particular individual modules or activities as they find appropriate.

The learning material will include four modules, each one focusing on particular subjects on gender education such as:

1. Basic concepts regarding gender and gender equality
2. Having pleasant relationships
3. Combating gender-based violence
4. Self transformation and social change

The learning material will be accessible via a Learning Management System (LMS) that will allow users to study learning material both on an individual basis and on a facilitated basis with synchronous and asynchronous courses. The course is based on interaction promoting communication, social networking, collaborative learning, reflective thinking, and information sharing among users. Parts of the learning material will also be accessible via a user-friendly mobile application.

At the moment we are creating the material of the four modules that will make up the G. EDU course as well as the e-learning platform which will host it!
